True to its values and aware of its responsibilities as a major player in the development and planning of the Ile-de-France region, the Aéroports de Paris Group is trying to be exemplary and ambitious in its respect of the environment. This decision is based on the process of ISO 14001 certification of its platforms, which is indicative of its commitment to Sustained Development. It takes into account the group's responsibility to society and its implementation is integrated into the economic logic of its strategic plan. Our policy's reality is based on the daily involvement of all our units and all our fellow workers. Each of them makes a serious effort to put this policy into practice, by paying particular attention to its spirit and letter, whilst taking into account respect for those around us as much as the statutory context of the field in which we operate.

## *The 4 principles of the Aéroports de Paris Group*

### **INCLUDE THE ENVIRONMENT SYSTEMATICALLY IN OUR ACTIVITIES**

Bolstered by our ambition to operate in a process which respects the environment, we are committed to using the best practices existing in this field, in all our activities (maintenance, operation, purchasing, management, contracts...). This principle aims not only at a strict respect of the regulations in force, but also respect of the additional commitments we have fixed for ourselves. It is applied in order to maintain continuous improvement.

### **ACT AS A RESPONSIBLE PLAYER**

We are aware of the considerable stakes that constitute the fight against climate change and the control of air quality, and so commit ourselves to act in favour of control of local (NOx particles) and global (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions for which we are directly responsible. This commitment is based on actions in the field of transport methods within or around our airports and better management of our existing and future heritage (High Environmental Quality – HEQ).

### **PREVENT**

In answer to the requirements for exemplarity we have fixed ourselves in the management of our own impacts, we are committed to implementing the necessary technical and human means to prevent the collective risks of pollution at our airports (rainwater, waste disposal). This rule applies particularly to the constant involvement of our fellow workers, but also to that of our direct or neighbouring territorial economic partners.

### **PROMOTE OUR VALUES AND PASS ON GOOD PRACTICES**

We wish to respect all parties (residents, communities, companies, public bodies) and are aware of the importance of our practices for the area we operate in, so we are committed to communicating with complete transparency about our environmental impacts, by increasing the importance of listening, dialogue and consultation. This aim also contributes to the support of the environmental management actions engaged by all the other players on our airport platforms.
