



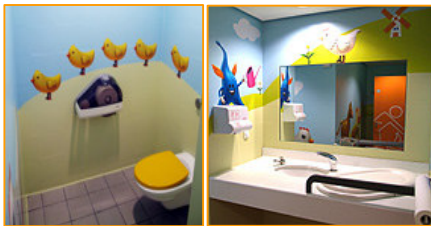

**A free baby stroller service and baby care rooms:
For Christmas, Aéroports de Paris offers a VIP welcome to the little ones**

For Christmas holidays, Aéroports de Paris is testing a new service for passengers with young children: the "baby care rooms". These new areas are totally equipped with items for young children care:



- baby care products vending machines such as wiping tissues, disposable diapers, ...
- baby changing mats,
- baby changing tables,
- infant seats,
- breast feeding seats,
- diaper disposals

Since December 1st, the first two "baby care rooms" have been installed Paris-Charles de Gaulle (terminals E and F). On the long run, 62 baby care rooms will be available in all the terminals of Paris-Orly and Paris-Charles de Gaulle airports.

For end-of-year holidays, Aéroports de Paris is testing, among passengers in terminal 2F, a free baby stroller service. If the service meets passengers' satisfaction, Aéroports de Paris could unroll this service in all its terminals.

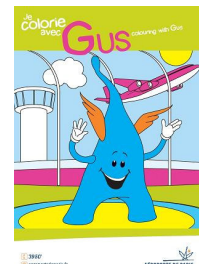


A new Gulli area at Paris Orly airport

As of December 21st, a new "Gulli" game area offering educational games for the entertainment of children will be installed at Paris-Orly Ouest, Hall 1.



For its baby care rooms, Aéroports de Paris has envisioned a decorating aimed at small children with the character "GUS". The new mascot will from now on indicate all the services offered to children. As of Christmas holidays, a colouring booklet with GUS will be offered to children. Aéroports de Paris builds, develops and manages airports including Paris-Orly, Paris-Charles de Gaulle and Paris-Le Bourget. Aéroports de Paris is the 2nd European airport group in terms of airport turnover and the 1st European airport group in terms of cargo and mail. Aéroports de Paris accommodates nearly 460 airlines, mainly the major actors of air transport.

Benefiting from an exceptional geographical location and a major trading area, the group's strategy is to modernize its terminal facilities and to upgrade its quality of service. It also intends to develop its retail and real estate business. In 2006, Aéroports de Paris Group had a turnover of 2,076.8 million euros, and a net result of 152.1 million euros. Aéroports de Paris handled 82.5 million passengers in 2006.
