**Aeronautical operations at Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport
Situation at 6.30 p.m.**

Airport operations are back to normal:

- The runways and taxiways of Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport are all operational.
- The de-icing stations allow normal traffic handling.
- Due to weather conditions, the French Civil Aviation Authority has lifted all restrictions on aircraft movements.

Because of tonight's exceptionally low temperatures, all the teams of Aéroports de Paris remain mobilized.
