**Summer goings and comings!
A special welcome awaits families with children
and free access to an interactive table, the "Digital Corner", at Paris-Orly**

For the traditional summer goings and comings, Aéroports de Paris will handle more than 900, 000 passengers at Paris-Orly and Paris-Charles de Gaulle airports. (On week-ends from July 30 to August 1st)

On this occasion families with children will be able to go calmly through security checkpoints thanks to a service especially adapted to their needs: "family access".

100 security and customer care staff (ICTS, Securitas, Alyzia and Mahola companies) have been trained by "le Rire Médecin" association in order to handle children and their parents and to allow them to board serenely. At the airport, "family access" to security checkpoints is identifiable thanks to a dedicated signage especially posted for the occasion.

Security staff will distribute a fun passport to all the children. Published by Ludétis, this passport includes a new Scooby-Doo adventure at Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport.

(Family access is available at Paris Charles-de Gaulle and Paris-Orly on July 30, 31 and August 1, 6, 7 and 8).

The Digital Corner at Paris-Orly



At Paris-Orly, passengers departing from terminal Sud can enjoy a technological innovation: the Digital Corner. This is the first time such an application has been available at an airport.

This new concept allows travellers to have fun and get informed through several digital applications such as checkers and chess games or a coloring game for the younger ones.

The Digital Corner can be used simultaneously by several passengers hence transforming the wait time in the boarding lounge into a pleasant and fun moment.

The Digital Corner will be trialled for a three-month period at Paris-Orly. If the results are conclusive, the offer could be extended to all the terminals. (The Digital Corner can be discovered in the boarding area of Concourse A in Terminal Sud at Paris-Orly).
